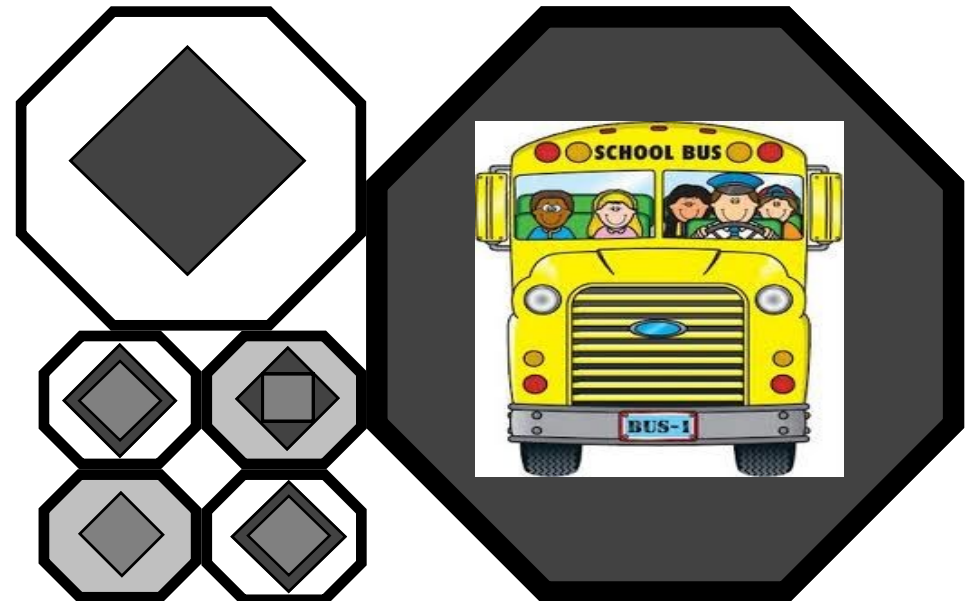

We look forward to seeing you there

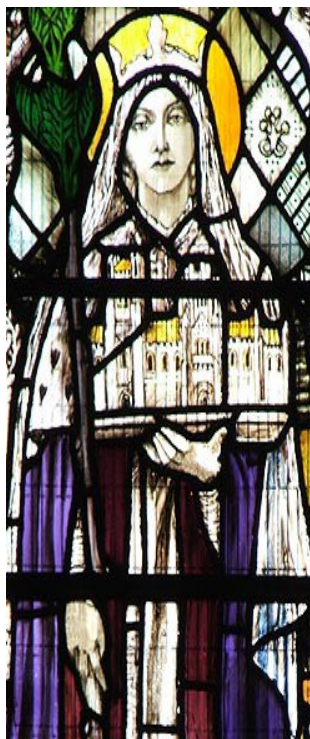


### **SCHOOLS CATHEDRAL DAYS**
