ELY Cathedral is widely acknowledged as one of the most beautiful Cathedrals in Europe. However, this magnificent building, along with its choral traditions, is an expensive inheritance to preserve and maintain, and we look to the generosity of benefactors to assist us.



Ely Cathedral plays a pivotal role within the community as a Christian place of worship. It is also a major visitor attraction which serves as an arts & music venue and cultural focal point for East Anglia and it offers a thriving education and outreach programme.

The Order of St Etheldreda is the fundraising arm of Ely Cathedral Trust. It is named after the founder of the monastery that occupied the site of Ely Cathedral c673AD.

Under the patronage of HRH Prince Philip, The Duke of Edinburgh, The Order was established in 1986, when £12 million was raised for urgent restoration work.

However the latest Quinquennial report identifies over £5 million of work still to be completed. Our aim is to raise enough money to preserve this national treasure whilst creating an environment in which the tradition of choral music will flourish and grow.
