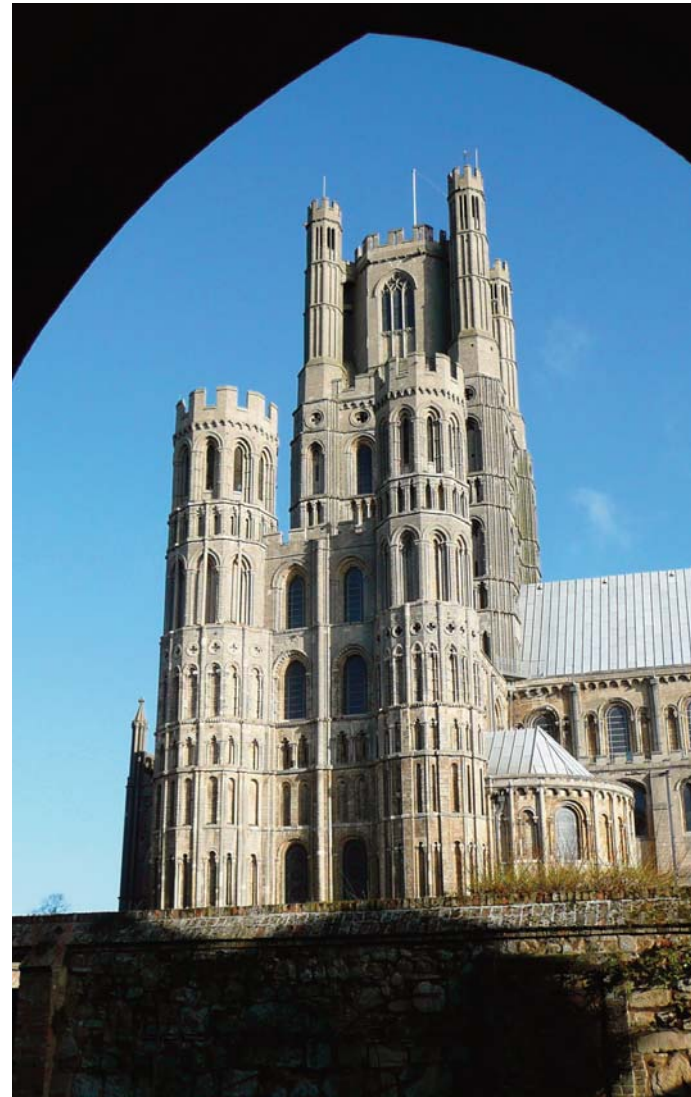
The famous, award winning Quaker Tapestry will be displayed within the Lady Chapel in Ely Cathedral from 31 January to 29 February 2012

The visual impact and beauty of the award winning Quaker Tapestry inspires all those who visit. Often compared with the Bayeux Tapestry, this masterpiece of storytelling is a celebration of life, people and events across the centuries. A myriad of stories are revealed from within the 77 captivating and colourful embroidery panels.

Created by 4,000 people in 15 countries, this is one of the world's largest community textiles. The modern embroidery depicts stories from the early railways, the iron industry, social reform, banking, botany, science and more...

39 of the 77 embroidered panels will travel to Ely from their permanent home at the Quaker Tapestry Centre at Kendal in the Lake District. Since its first public exhibition in 1989, the Tapestry has travelled to over 150 venues in the UK, Europe and America. The annual Roadshow is an unqualified success, attracting thousands of visitors each year.
