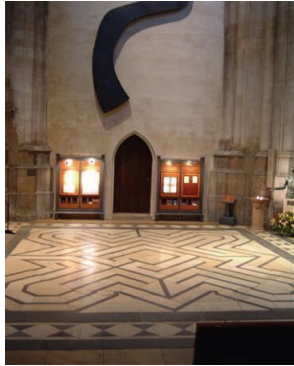
A BIG THANKYOU!
