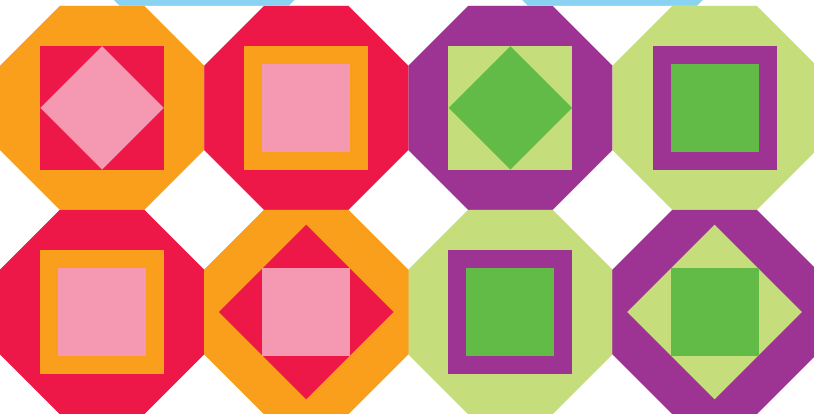
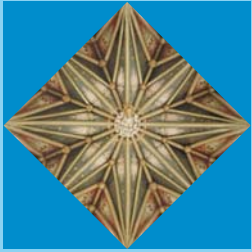

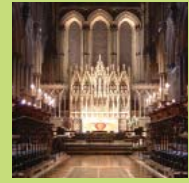

We aim to make the Cathedral accessible to young people, both as a building and as a living community of faith.

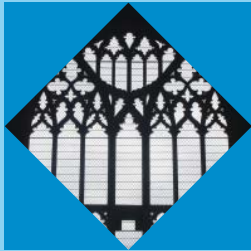
