Ely Cathedral Choir has been part of the English choral tradition since the mid-sixteenth century and in terms of its monastic heritage, can be traced back considerably further, to the time of King Canute.

Many of England's finest musicians started life as cathedral choristers. This is no surprise, because professionalism is the hallmark of a Cathedral Choir.

Today the Choir consists of some 22 boy choristers who are supported by gentlemen singers. Alongside daily rehearsals and services, there is a demanding schedule of concerts, broadcasts, and recordings.

An important aspect of the choir's work is to take cathedral music to other parts of the world. The Ely Cathedral Choir tours are an extension of the Cathedral's Christian Outreach, enabling audiences to experience, first hand, the magnificence of English Church Music.

Since 1990 the Choir has had successful tours around Western and Eastern Europe, Canada and America.
